Right or Wrong, we are in Iraq, and as American's we must pull together. No one could have known the carnage we would be facing in Iraq. Hindsight is great. If we could have seen ahead we might have done things differently. As a nation, we need to support the families of our brave soldiers.

"Because of the IED bombs going off, this is a war like no other. They are causing severe head injury of Mammoth Proportions. This is a NATIONAL TRAGEDY.

Tyndale House Publishers, has generously sent me fifty copies of "FIGHTING FOR DAVID," to send to Army Rehabilitation Facilities. Our son, David, was not expected to even open his eyes after his head injury. If you read the book, you will see that bringing him home and using a unique therapy called patterning has done miracles for him. It only takes volunteers!!
