Without the Lord and the body of Christ helping us with all David's home therapy, this wonderful love story would have never been published. It is our prayer that it will bring hope, help and faith to others who are facing difficult struggles.

As you will see, Pat Boone, is one of the endorsers for the book. We know his family has suffered much the same as ours as a result of head injury. It was a joy to see him wishing Paul a very happy birthday last year.

In Touch Ministry came out last spring to interview and film a story about David and the Body of Christ. Tonya Stoneman wrote the article for their July magazine, and last August it ran on their Website. It is to air February 24' on their weekly TV program.
